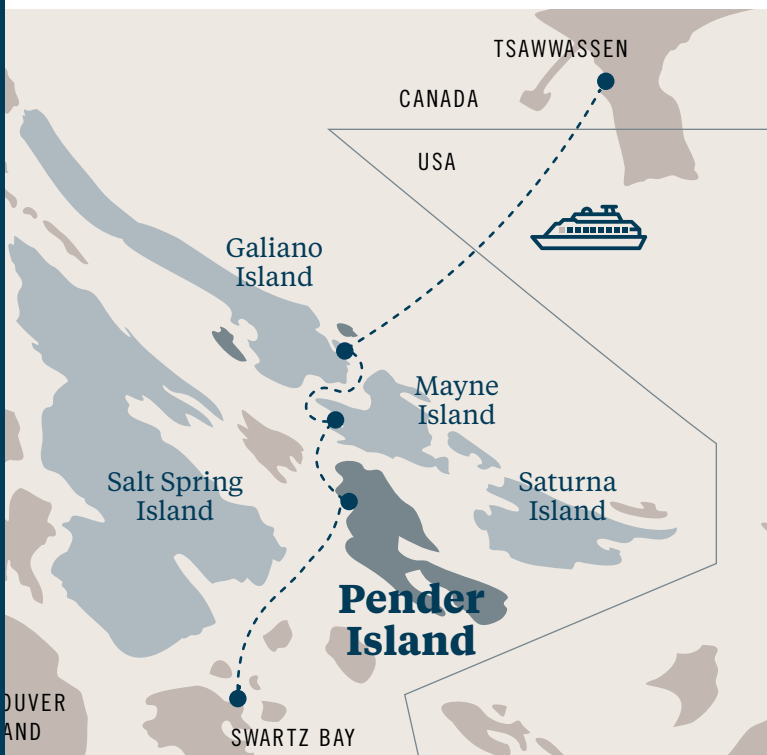


## Welcome

Don't be surprised if locals offer you a ride at one of the many car stops, give directions to a great place to eat, or help you find comfortable overnight accommodations. Pender is a friendly, safe, family-oriented community of people committed to a healthy lifestyle and a healthy environment.

Located on the unceded territories of the Hul'qumi'num Treaty Group and SENĆOTEN speaking people of WSANEĆ First Nations, we extend our gratitude and thanks, acknowledging our privilege to enjoy this beautiful place once known as SDAY\_ES (stey/əs).

Originally a single island, a canal was excavated in 1903 creating two islands, North and South Pender, now connected by a tall single-lane wooden bridge. We invite you to delve deeper into Pender's rich history by visiting the Pender Islands Museum, where you can explore both Indigenous traditions and settler heritage.



## Getting here

### By ferry

From Tsawwassen (Vancouver): multiple daily sailings, stops and transfers vary, a direct sailing will take approximately two hours. Reservations are highly recommended.

From Swartz Bay (Victoria): multiple daily sailings, stops and transfers vary, a direct sailing will take approximately 45 minutes. This route cannot be booked in advance.

## FOOD

Find plenty of restaurants, cafes, and pubs offering both casual and upscale dining with a variety of options to suit every budget and taste. miss stopping at roadside farm stands for produce, preserves, eggs, and more. You will also find plenty of local items at the Saturday Farmers Market which runs from the spring through fall at the Community Hall. Watch for other markets on Wednesdays and Saturdays throughout the year.

## DRINK

Visit Pender Island's only winery, Sea Star Vineyards and Winery, and enjoy a tasting or take home a bottle as a keepsake. With its stunning hillside setting, Sea Star has hosted countless celebrations and supports local conservation efforts. Twin Island Cider is also a must-do. Stop by for naturally fermented

cider, perry or kombucha, fill a growler, or pick up a rotating selection of bottled flavours. For something new, Bee Wild Distillery offers spirits crafted from farm-harvested botanicals, honey and apples. Visit their tasting room to savour "Pender's spirit" or take a bottle home.

## ACTIVITIES

### CYCLING

Although Pender has steep, winding roads, there are many areas with scenic, moderate routes. Roads are narrow so take extra care. Kids will love the pumptrack.

### ON THE WATER

Protected bays and inland lakes make the island perfect for swimming, kayaking, canoeing and paddle-boarding. Rentals available on island or bring your own.

### HIKING

Climb the Bluffs overlooking the Salish Sea, meander through the Enchanted Forest, or trek to the top of Mount Norman or George Hill for stunning views.

### FARM STANDS

Savour the taste of our unique terroir. In late spring through fall, stop by farm stands laden with fresh fruit, vegetables, and eggs.

### GOLF & DISC GOLF

Pender offers a traditional 9-hole public golf course and an internationally famous disc golf course, which are great ways to be active and outdoors.

### ART & MUSIC

A creative hub, stop by artists' studio hours to enjoy painting, photography, jewellery, woodworking, pottery and more. Check out art shows, catch live music or join a jam session at venues around the island.

### PARK, TRAILS, SHORES

Many shore access points, dozens of trails, and plenty of parkland provide generous opportunities to enjoy nature. Brooks Point Regional Park is a favourite with great views of Mount Baker and possible whale sightings. Explore diverse ecosystems and follow Leave No Trace guidelines.



## NATURE

Pender Island boasts rolling hills covered in coastal forests dominated by towering Douglas firs and cedars. Along its bluffs, twisted arbutus trees cling to the rocks, adding to the island's charm. During spring, the landscape is dotted with dainty wildflowers. Its rugged coastline offers secluded coves bordered by logs and vibrant tidal pools bustling with marine life. Nature enthusiasts can indulge in observing eagles, orcas, and seals in their natural habitat, especially at stops along The Whale Trail. Renowned for its mild climate, spring comes as early as February to the island, making it a haven year-round.



## RECREATION

With trails ranging from easy walks to vigorous hikes, kayak tours, and lovely beaches and public shoreline, Pender is a paradise for leisurely adventure. Forest and intertidal ecosystems offer plenty to explore. Be sure not to handle any sensitive sea life. Wildlife such as bald eagles, porpoises, whales, and deer are perfect for quiet observation from a distance. Look for native plants such as phantom orchids and fawn lilies, while staying on designated trails to avoid trampling them. Here, we treat all neighbours with consideration and respect, including the non-human species (from trees to animals) with whom we share space. Stop by the Conservancy at Hope Bay to learn more about our island ecology.

From a high-end resort, to elegant B&B's and glamping experiences and rustic camping among the trees, Pender offers accommodation for every budget and style. No matter

















where you stay, enjoy peaceful nights under the stars and waking to the birds' morning music. Reservations are highly recommended, especially in the busy summer season.

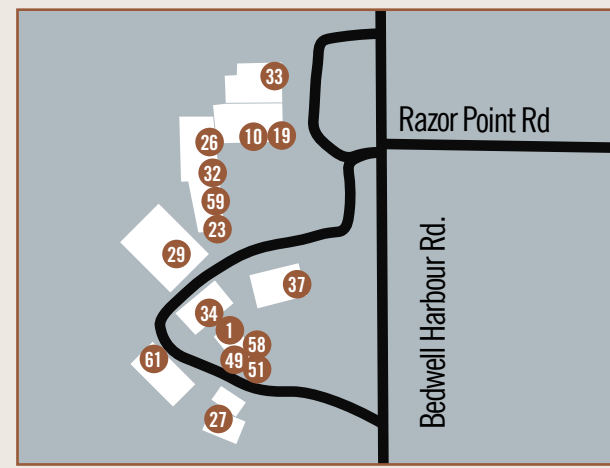
## PENDER ISLAND MAP

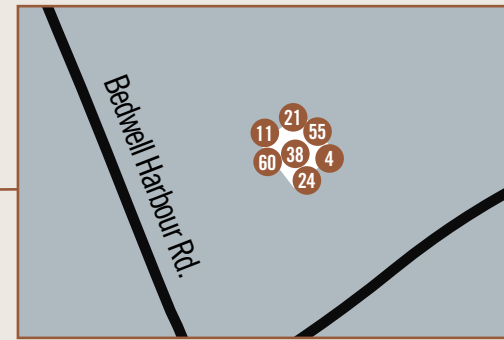
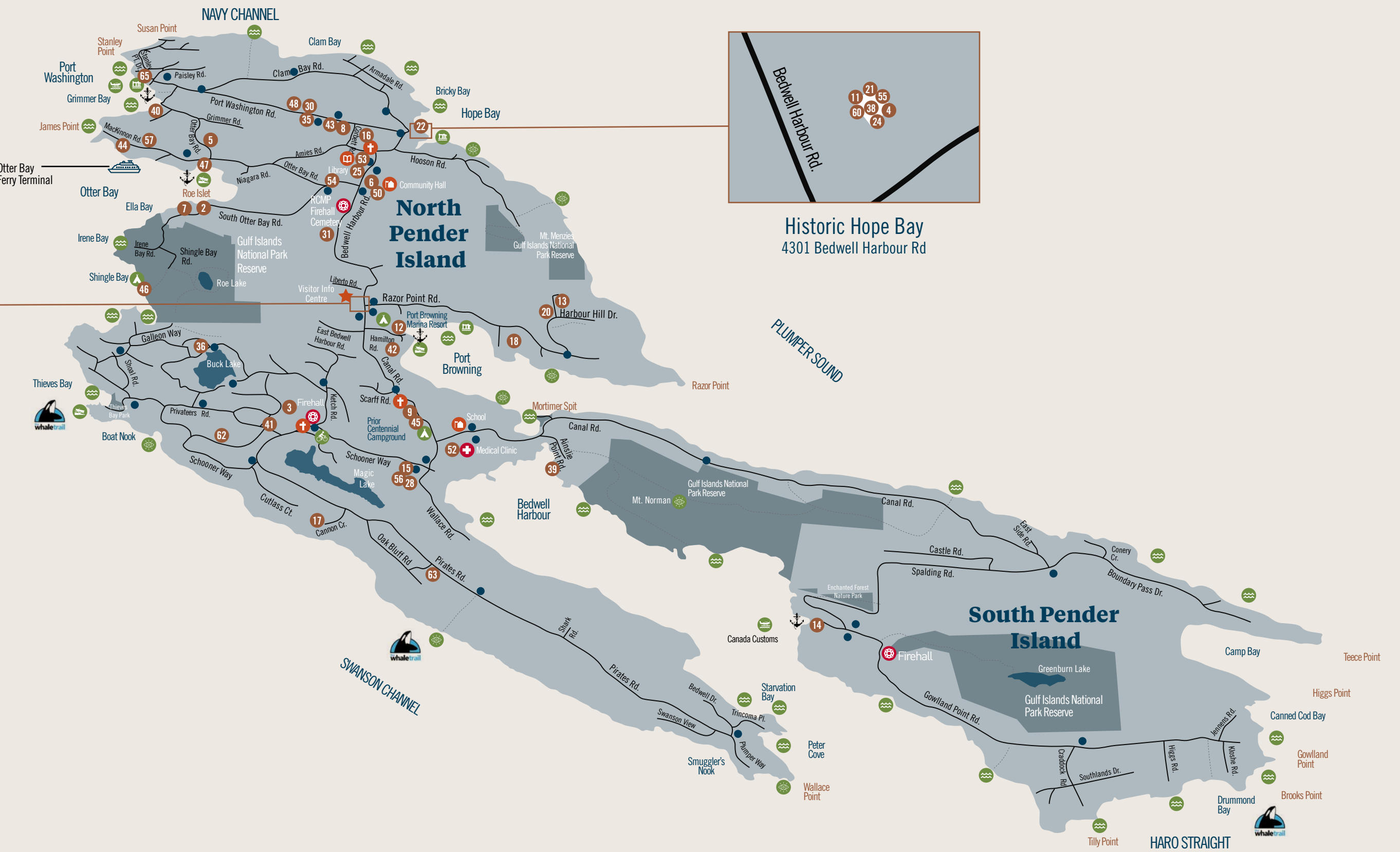
